Students receive a Student Planner. Students should have a **backpack** large enough to carry a legal-size folder.

ECA provides elementary students with the following supplies to use on campus: pencils, glue, ruler, and paper. ALL items sent from home that are for the personal use of the student (denoted with an ☞) should be **labeled** such as notebooks, folders, clothes, pillows, pillowcases, and blankets. In Elementary items not marked with an ☞ are for shared student use.

Supplies on this list will be needed for the hybrid learning models, when students begin school on campus. However, some supplies such as notebooks and binders may be used at home during distance learning depending on government protocols.
